Three Months training Course on
“Care of textiles and other organic materials”

National Museum is organizing three-month intensive training course on “Care of textiles and other organic materials”. The course shall start from January 27, 2016 to April 26, 2016. The aim of training is to impart theoretical and practical training in the field of Conservation of all types of textiles and other organic materials.

Candidates from Academies, Departments of Archaeology, Museums, Archives, University, allied institutions and practicing conservators from all over India shall be preferred. The basic qualification is graduation preferably in science with one year experience in the field of art conservation. Ten candidates shall be selected on the basis of merit. Suitable scholarship shall be awarded to deserving candidates.

Employees of Govt. Institutions may draw T.A/D.A from their respective Institutions.
