Subject: Filling up of one post of Deputy Curator (Arms and Armour), Group 'A', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial in Level-10 of Pay Matrix [Pre-revised-PB-3, Rs. 15600-39100 + 5400/- Grade Pay] by Composite Method [Deputation (including short term contract) plus promotion] in the National Museum, New Delhi under the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India.

Applications are invited from eligible officers for appointment to one post of Deputy Curator (Arms and Armour) Group 'A', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial in Level-10 of Pay Matrix [Pre-revised-PB-3, Rs. 15600-39100 + 5400/- Grade Pay] by Composite Method [Deputation (including short term contract) plus promotion] in the National Museum, New Delhi under the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India.

2. Job Description:

To conduct the specialized work of scholarly study, cataloguing, research, to contribute to publication, to carry on collection, safeguarding, exhibitions and interpreting for education and culture and the material in the field of Archaeology.

3. Eligibility

Officers under the Central Government or State Governments or Union Territories or Universities or Recognized Research Institutions or Public Sector Undertakings or Semi Government or Statutory or autonomous organizations:-

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/Department;

OR

(ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in post in Level-7 of Pay Matrix [Pre-revised PB-2, Rs. 9300-34800+4600/- Grade Pay (Pre-revised Rs. 6500-10,500) or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department;

OR

(iii) with eight years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in post in Level-6 of Pay Matrix [Pre-revised PB-2, Rs. 9300-34800+4200/- Grade Pay (Pre-revised Rs. 5500-9000)] or equivalent in the parent cadre/Department; and

(b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

Essential:-

(i) (a) Master's Degree of a recognized University or equivalent in History or Sanskrit or Pali or Prakrit or Persian or Arabic or Archaeology or Anthropology or Fine Arts or History of Art; and

(b) Diploma in Museology from a recognized University/institution or equivalent.

OR

Master's Degree from a recognized University or equivalent in Museology with History as a subject at Bachelor's degree level.
