Frederick M. Asher is a professor of art history at the University of Minnesota, a specialist in the art of South Asia. His current interests include the visual culture of the Indian Ocean as well as that of Buddhist pilgrimage sites. He has served as President of the American Institute of Indian Studies and then as Chair of the Institute's Board of Trustees and has served as President of the [U.S.] National Committee for the History of Art and a member of the Bureau [Executive Committee] of CIHA (Comité International d'Histoire de l'Art).
