Sanjib Kumar Singh is a trained archaeologist and museologist, Head of the Publications Department of the National Museum, and curator of the Nizam Jewels exhibition. He has authored several books, including, *Buddhist Art in the National Museum Collection*, *An Introduction to the Indus Valley Civilisation*, *India Bronze: Ecstasy of Classical Art-Indian Bronze from the National Museum Collection*, *Glory that was Harappan Civilisation* and other others. He was deputed by the government of India to deliver lectures and mount exhibitions in USA, France, Germany, Japan, China, S. Korea, UK, Singapore etc.



Usha R Balakrishnan is the pre-eminent art-historian of Indian jewellery globally. Dr. Balakrishnan documented and studied the Nizam collection for the Government of India, and has authored several books, most notably, *Jewels of the Nizam*, *Treasures of the Deccan: Jewels of the Nizams*, *India: Jewels that Enchanted the World*, *Alamkara: The Beauty of Ornament*, and *Dance of the Peacock: Jewellery Traditions of India*.
